The Chief Financial Officer is responsible for overseeing and managing A+ Education Partnership's fiscal activities including budgeting, reporting, auditing, and more. A+ works with an annual budget of more than \$9 million in funding from private contributions, state, local and federal sources. With two offices in Montgomery and Birmingham and 29 employees, A+ Education Partnership is looking for a seasoned CFO to manage the company's fiscal activities and ensure that we continue to be a good steward of our financial resources.

CFO Roles and Responsibilities

Oversee the company's fiscal activities including budgeting, reporting, auditing and treasury management.

- Management of bookkeeping functions, procedures/controls, timely reconciliations and monthly ledger reviews
- Preparation and work with external auditors for annual audit process
- Cash balance monitoring and treasury management for all divisions
- Manage insurance coverage
- Handle fiscal agency duties

- Work with program management on pricing for various program components
- Assist with creation of grant budgets

Serve as company's payroll and benefits manager

- Manage annual health coverage renewal process
- Handle payroll audits and 5500 submission
- New employee setup and benefits/tax changes for existing employees
